## **100 CLUB LOTTERY**

We are a group of volunteers from the above area who are trained to help people in our community if they get into certain difficulties - cardiac arrest, breathing difficulties or sustain heavy bleeding are some of the examples where we can help. We know that when such a life threatening condition occurs it is simple things that save lives as well as the type of assistance available and the speed of response.

Our Responders are notified of a call out by the North West Ambulance Service and are trained and equipped to provide certain treatment in life threatening situations prior to the arrival of an ambulance. In view of our remote area, adverse weather conditions or a serious major incident the ambulance and paramedics can sometimes be delayed. All First Responders are trained and supported in our training by the North West Ambulance Service (NHS Trust).

We need to raise funds to purchase more Defibrillators as ideally we need one in each of the villages above. In addition to this we have to cover the costs of mapping every single residence so that our Responders can get to a call out without difficulty, and we also have to cover the monthly charges from the central mobile supplier we use to notify First Responders of a call out. Our Responders are all notified by the Ambulance Control Centre when there is an incident in the area.

The Upper Eden and Tebay/Orton First Responders Groups have decided to run a "100 Club" to raise more funds for the purchase of more Defibrillators (approx. cost is £900.00 each), for that reason we need your support. For the modest contribution of £3.00 per month, you will not only be supporting our local First Responders but also giving yourself a chance of winning a monthly prize.

We hope that you will join the "100 Club" as a means of assisting your community and our volunteers.

The basic features of the Club Lottery are as follows:

- For a payment of £3.00 each month, you will be allocated a Draw Number which will be entered into a monthly draw with a maximum of 100 fellow supporters of Upper Eden First Responders
- Lottery income will be £3,600 per year if 100 contributors take part
- One quarter of total proceeds will be allocated as prizes, totalling £900.00 per year
- There will be a monthly draw with the following prizes (see notes 11 & 12 below):
- Ist monthly prize £40.00
- 2<sup>nd</sup> monthly prize £20.00
- 3<sup>rd</sup> monthly prize £15.00

We are convinced this will be a popular way of raising money because of the good chances of winning one of the 36 prizes to be drawn each year and sharing the £900.00 prize money.

## **100 CLUB LOTTERY RULES**

The following will be the Club Lottery Rules:

- The "100 Club" will be operated under The Gambling Act 2005, which deals with a Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be the Clerk of Ravenstonedale Parish Council.
- 2. The Club reserves the right to alter the Rules of the "100 Club" from time to time, as may be necessary.
- 3. All profits made by the "100 Club" will be used to support the First Responders
- 4. The Lottery will be limited to 100 members over the age of 16 years (but see also paragraph 12).
- 5. The subscription will be £3.00 per month, payable by Standing Order on the I<sup>st</sup> day of each month (or annually in a single payment of £36.00, to be made before the 5<sup>th</sup> working day of October each year). On receipt of a single annual payment or a Standing Order form, the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. For each additional £3.00 paid per month (or single annual payment of £36.00), an additional Draw Number will be allocated.
- 6. A draw will take place **every month** on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month for cash prizes. Winners of prizes will be notified by letter and the results of the draw will be open for inspection and published in The Link and in due course on our website.
- 7. A quarter of the total annual subscriptions will be paid out in the form of cash prizes; for this purpose the "100 Club" year will run from 1st October to 30th September.
- 8. The draws will be conducted in the presence of by not less than 2 committee members one of which will be an officer (Chairman, Treasurer or Secretary).
- 9. No "100 Club" participant will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the 5<sup>th</sup> working day of the month in which the draw is taking place. The promoter reserves the right to reallocate any Draw Number where payment has not been received on time.
- 10. Prizes will be paid by cheque which will be sent through the post and only to the person holding the winning number.
- 11. In the event of there being less than 100 participants, prizes shall be awarded on a pro rata basis of the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
- 12. In the event of there being more than 100 applications to join the "100 Club", the Club will issue the required number of Draw Numbers to satisfy demand and prizes will be awarded on a pro rata basis at the discretion of the Committee and based of the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
- 13. Participants can cancel their entry in the Lottery at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Treasurer, c/o I Stenkrith View, Nateby Road, Kirkby Stephen, Cumbria CA17 (and if paying by Standing Order, they should inform their bank). Any decision by the Upper Eden First Responders to wind up the "100 Club" will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.
